

APPOINTMENT SEQUENCING

1. HIPAA Form & Informed Consent Form
2. Health History
3. Radiology History

- (Discontinue in March of 1st year, with instructor approval)
5. Hard Tissue Charting

INSTRUCTOR CHECK POINT

7. Periodontal Evaluation
Signature (supervising faculty)
8. Gingival Evaluation inc. Perio Diagnosis
Signature (SUPERVISING DENTIST)
9. Calculus Charting
Discontinue charting of calculus at mid-semester of 1st year on Class I and II (DH 112). Accurate calculus description on perio form will replace this requirement.
10. Determine need for radiographs
Signature (SUPERVISING DENTIST)

Note: Dentist must review perio on radiographs and sign for all periodontally involved clients following student's review

Radiographic Forms to be completed by students:
Quality - supervising faculty signs after student reviews, student need not complete critique at this point but should be able to identify retakes
Interp - dentist reviews and signs, only after student has completed charting all pathology including periodontal conditions. Client must be present in the dental chair.

INSTRUCTOR CHECK POINT for ASSESSMENTS

Supervising faculty will request the supervising dentist to check all pathology after assessments are checked, radiographs are taken and radiographic pathology is noted on the Radiographic Interp form and periodontal involvement is noted on the back of the perio chart. This must be done prior to completion of the client. The dentist may be consulted at any time during assessments if the faculty thinks it is necessary. The dentist should check all pathology noted on the EIOE, diagnose all dental pathology and gingival conditions, and review radiographs. The dentist is to diagnose hard tissue pathology, but does not need to check the complete dental charting if it has been reviewed by the dental hygiene faculty. The dentist will sign all appropriate assessment forms and sign the Referral of Conditions if pathology is present. Diagnosis of all pathology and the periodontal diagnosis must be written in the client's Treatment Record by the dentist.
